FIVE SISTERS UNVEILS COMPLETED RENOVATIONS

We are excited to announce the completion of our recent renovations, made possible through the National Historic Trust for Preservation's Backing Historic Small Restaurants grant program made possible by American Express. The unveiling marks a new chapter for the restaurant, serving up soulful flavors and rich history since its inception.

"We are incredibly honored to have been chosen as a recipient of the Historic Restaurants Grant," said Jean Pierre N'Dione, co-owner of Five Sisters' Blues Café. "This support has allowed us to preserve the legacy of our restaurant while enhancing the experience for our guests. These renovations honor our history while preparing us for a bright future."



The renovations include:

- refurbishment of the marquee sign
- relocation and installation of a new main entrance
- ADA compliant ramp
- lighting and awning
- mural creation
- lighting installation on the east side of the building commemorating Ray Charles

The enhancements were designed to maintain the café's authentic charm while preserving the historic neighborhood, providing our community opportunities for connection. Five Sisters' Blues Café has long been a beacon of Pensacola's Black heritage, celebrated for its soulful Southern cuisine, live blues performances and deep community roots. The name pays homage to the five sisters who inspired its founding, representing family, resilience, and a love of good food. The Historic Small Restaurants Grant, part of American Express' broader commitment to supporting Black businesses, recognizes the cultural and historical significance of establishments like Five Sisters' Blues Café. By providing financial support, the program aims to preserve the stories and contributions of restaurants across the nation.

"This is more than just a renovation for us," said co-owner Collier Merrill, "It's a celebration of our past, a thank-you to our community, and a promise to continue serving as a gathering place for generations to come."

NAPA TO NAPLES RECAP

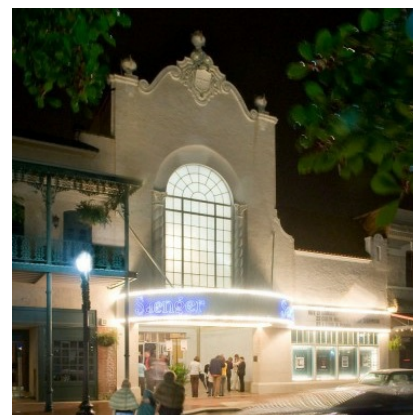
